



Curriculum Integration in Minecraft: Education Edition

Mapping specific M:EE lessons to standards can be a great way to introduce M:EE to educators and students for the first time. Educators will have a clear understanding of when to use the M:EE lesson and resources in their curriculum.



Aligning M:EE lessons to curriculum can be done in one of two ways: 1) Taking existing M:EE worlds and lesson plans and adjusting the activities to meet local standards, or 2) Creating a new lesson plan that achieves a specific standard.



Not all M:EE lessons need pre-built Minecraft worlds. Some lessons have students start in a template “Blocks of Grass” world where they will be primarily building and demonstrating knowledge. Ex: have students research and build the salmon life cycle in a template world.
